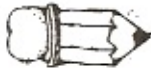

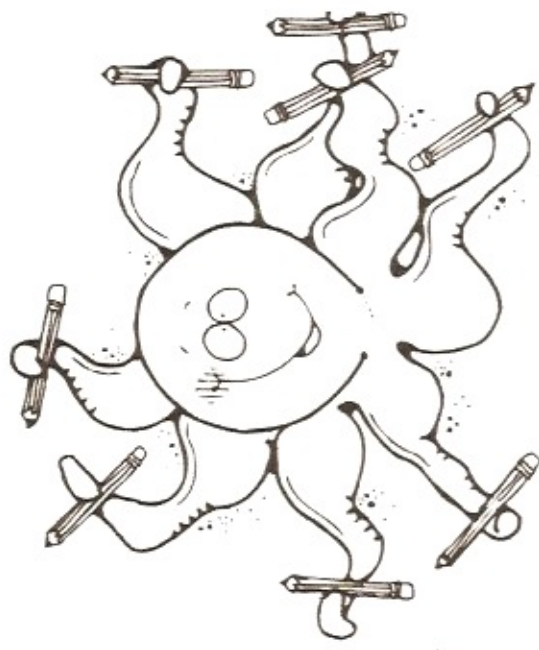

A Attendance: Many 2nd grade learning activities are group oriented and involve interaction with classmates. Therefore, it is next to impossible to recreate these activities at home. Please view school as a priority and see to it that your child attends every day except in cases of illness or emergency.

B Book Orders: Scholastic book orders will be sent home on a regular basis. This is a great way to purchase books inexpensively. You will also have access to order these books online at www.scholastic.com/bookclubs and use the class activation code: GM9LM

C Communications: Please feel free to contact me at any time with questions or concerns. You can either write me a note or e-mail me through our class website.

D Dismissal: School ends at 2:24. Please send a note if your child will be dismissed at a different time or is to go home a different way than his/her normal schedule.

E Emergencies: Please make sure we have the correct emergency numbers and information on file for your child.

F Field Trips: Our class will participate in field trips this year. Permission slips must be returned for your child to attend.

G Grading Scales: The following grading system is used in 2nd grade: 3 (Proficient) = 80%-100%, 2 (Partially Proficient) = 59%-79%, 1 (Not Proficient) = 0%-58%

H Homework: At the beginning of each week, your child will receive his/her homework agenda. Your child's homework will be given, reviewed and collected daily. The agenda will be collected at the beginning of the following week. Homework can also be found on our class website.

I InfoTech: My class has been involved in completing technology projects. Some projects include power point presentations, iMovies, and websites. In previous years our class participated in InfoTech. If available, I intend to schedule this year's class for participation also.

J Journals: Your child will have a journal in every subject this year.

K Kindness: We will learn to be kind to ourselves and others every day.

L Library: We will visit the school library to check our books. Please make sure all books are returned by then to avoid suspended library privileges and/or fines.

M Management: At the end of each week your child will bring home their Behavior Chart and Academic Progress Report. These need to be reviewed, signed and return to school or Monday.

P Practice: The skills learned in class needs to be practiced often, so please ask your child to read for you, quiet him/her on math facts or visit our class website for more practice.

Q Questions: Reading comprehension is important. Ask your child questions about the books he/she reads.

R Reading, Decoding & Fluency: Reading is understanding the meaning of the text. Decoding is an important reading strategy because it links written words into the sounds and meaning of spoken words. Fluency is saying the word with accuracy and correct pronunciation.
